It's 11" x 5.5" x 4", with a right-angle (hugs the wall) plug. It can live on the floor or desk.

Optionally, you may want a second one for Ike's iMac. They're heavy, so you definitely want them shipped to you.

I'll install them so that when the power goes out for an extended time, it'll shut down the computer(s) to avoid damage.

So you know. The battery wears out after 18 months or so, so they'll need to be replaced. I can show you how that's done.
