What's the speed in the bedroom?

The kitchen sits between the TV (where the WiFi router/modem is) and the bedroom, so the pipes and appliances are likely dampening the signal.

How much it dampens it would be good to know to balance against the solutions below.

- A. We can't really move the modem out from behind the kitchen without running cables over the middle of the floor.
- B. These devices are supposed to be able to extend any WiFi network, but I've never tried them for that purpose, but they're the easiest extension available.

C.
