To pay with points for upgrade - you book coach ticket and pay difference in fare (plus possible change fee) business/first class ticket partially with points (20% back), let's say you pay coach value with money and the change fee.

1.00 = 100 points.

Other option - to transfer American Express points to the airline and get mileage upgrade (we can transfer points miles. But mileage upgrade could be tricky, has to be available, sometimes it is not the lowest fare to be upgraded to do it yourself (with certain airlines), but I can transfer points.
