Hey guys.. I would like to get this mirror ordered for 5 Palms outside wall. Arran gave me the measurement of the wall as being 32' wide x 21' high, thus we would need 672 sq. ft of mirror. I've just spoken to someone from this company:

and she told me that they can do a maximum size acrylic mirror sheet of 96"x48". They say their mirror is OK for outside application. They also sell the adhesive and J Bars for installing. The only thing that concerns me about using J Bars is that they will rust outside. I'm not sure how this should be installed? What do you think about ordering from here? Should I have them put a quote together for the amount we need?
