By now all of you should have seen the GPR Match list (also posted in VC8 clinic). For the most part, everyone got their 1st, 2nd, or 3rd choice. However, please understand, if you ranked highly programs that are consistently picked (e.g. you ranked metro #1, monte #2, etc), your chances significantly decrease of actually obtaining that spot just by the math alone (there are only 2 spots per group at a place like metro, but 15 in 1 group chose it as #1!!!!). The process is random within each iteration. If you matched at your 4-8th choice, know that Dr Mandel wanted me to randomly assign you all to a hospital so at least this way there is some say in the process.
