I spoke to Dr. Kolker's office. It's totally fine for your mom to go in and do her pre-op a week before surgery. Please email or call Jillian ([REDACTED] <mailto:[REDACTED]> / [REDACTED]) directly to set up the new appointment. Important to remember is that two weeks before surgery she cannot take any

NSAIDs (that includes Motrin, Advil and any other anti-inflammatory drugs), as well as aspirin of course or any other blood thinners, including fish oil.

To reschedule the Dr. Fassano appointment just email or call Melissa Bellino ([REDACTED] / [REDACTED] <mailto:[REDACTED]>).

This should be all you need. Once surgery is done she needs to stay here for at least two weeks before she can go back.
