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These 2 show how the design is crooked; it veers to the =eft. If you notice in the second photo, this is of the adjacent wall to =he cabinets, it is also skewed; the black diamonds are gradually =etting smaller against the wall. So, if it's crooked against both the =all and the cabinets, it would be safe to conclude that the flooring is =ndeed skewed itself, not that the cabinets or wall is =kewed.

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There are =ears in the material in several of the corners. Not sure how this will =e fixed? I understand caulking will help the edges look finished, but =t won't hide the =ears.

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
