Because of the many holidays in May and the Embassy being closed for them, the Consular section is booked solid, but I have been told the following by my colleagues from Consular:

"She needs to make an appointment. She can do that either online or by calling the call center (<http://france.usembassy.gov/niv/appointments.html> <<http://france.usembassy.gov/niv/appointments.html>>). It is doubtful she will be able to get an appointment on Wednesday or Thursday as the wait time for work visa appointments is about 7 working days. However, appointments do open up if there are cancellations, and the call center can help tell her if there are available appointments next week. I assume she has an approved petition for whichever type of work visa she will be applying for. We usually do return visa-ed passports by mail, but if asked, will allow the applicant to pick up personally in case of imminent travel. The visa is usually ready for pickup in 1-3 days."

I am so sorry I am unable to be of more assistance and I hope you can understand how we cannot influence their work. I wish her the best of luck and hope it works out.
