>> Hey guys. I went to PC Richards yesterday to pick out new appliances. I am having trouble finding a refrigerator which will fit the current dimensions of what's there. All the current ones are 28" wide by 26" deep by about 65" high. I can't find anything that's 28" wide that isn't deeper than 29 inches, in which case it would stick out more than desired from the cabinets. I did find one however that's 27.5" wide by 24" deep, but 75" high, which is too high with the cabinet above the fridge. I didn't have a chance to specifically look, but wondering if it's doable to remove the cabinet over the fridge so we can fit a taller fridge in the space? I'm sort of at a loss as to what to do about sourcing a fridge with the current dimensions otherwise.
