My brother is going =o go up to a hotel which has a satellite system tonight to send the pictures =very expensive). The town is down to one power generator and certain =arts of the town get power at different times, not predictable times either =nd both power and Telekom are needed to send pictures.

The crates are =ade. I have to get export permits from the National Museum and I need the =ictures to get to the Museum so they can issue the permits.

I am sorry but this is a very third world. Please apologize =o your client. I hope to have pictures to show you within 24 =ours.
