Below are a few configuration options for the media center that will only fit the media units. The first one would have 3 long adjustable shelves, so 2 units would sit side by side on each shelf and only 2 large doors on the outside.

The second option would have a fixed "cross" in the middle creating 4 cubby holes with each cubby having an adjustable shelf in the middle. (So 2 media pieces per cubby) This would require there to be 4 separate doors on the outside.

If we want extra storage space, we can choose a larger configuration going vertical or horizontal, but I worry this may be too large of a piece. What do you think?

And of course the unit would be white with either stainless steel base and pulls, or natural steel base and pulls
