If you =ant to connect the shower with already mixed water, a warm water regulator can be =nstalled upstreams. The temperature will be decided upstreams and outside, only 1 =ine is necessary to connect the shower with water temperature settled =pstreams. This is in case you don't want or don't need to get the hot =nd cold equipment with 2 taps on the shower ( which requires the =nstallation of 2 pipes ).
