**Subject:** Russian visas

I spoke to an agency who helps with Russian visas. They said the best visa for us to get would be a business visa which is good for one year. They can apply for the invitation for us which takes 2 weeks to get. Once we have the invitation, we have to give our passports to the Russian consulate for 3 days to process the visa. All we have to give them for the invite is a copy of our passports, the company name, address, phone number and your position in the company. If we gave them that info today, we would have the invite by Dec=31st, but the Russian Consulate is closed from Jan 1-10, thus we could have the visas by Jan.13 at the earliest. The cost is \$800

Otherwise, if you want to stick with a tourist visa they are only good for one month and can be processed in a day. =?xml
