So basically, I would just like a simple covering for this area with 3 removable metal grates to access the radiator and AC unit, but I would like the AC to be properly built in so it looks nice when I remove the grate to use the AC (unfortunately not enough air gets through the grates when it covers the AC so must be removed when in use in order to feel the air).

I wanted to give you this update for when you are getting a quote since it will be a much simpler job. Could you give me a quote for both just a plain white painted finish as well as a white laquer finish?
