&gt;&gt;If you lock your keys in the car and the spare key is home, call  
&gt;&gt;someone on your cell phone.

&gt;&gt;Hold your cell phone about afoot from your car door and have the other  
&gt;&gt;person at your home press the unlock button, holding it near the phone  
&gt;&gt;on their end. Your car will unlock. Saves someone from having to drive  
&gt;&gt;your keys to you.

&gt;&gt;Distance is no object. You could be hundreds of miles away, and if you  
&gt;&gt;can reach someone who has the other "remote" for your car, you  
can  
&gt;&gt;unlock the doors (or the trunk!)
