Dear Friends and Neighbors,

This afternoon, remnants of Tropical Storm Emily caused heavy rains throughout South Florida, leading to the national weather service to issue flood advisories for our city. This led to Miami Beach experiencing record rainfall that caused many of our streets and neighborhoods to flood. &nb=p;This was further exacerbated by power outages citywide, that caused drainage infrastructure to be temporarily offline.

The city continues to work to mitigate flooding by upgrading the stormwater system that drains the city's streets during rain and tidal events. However, severe events can cause temporary flooding that impacts us all. The new system is designed to handle 7.5 inches of rainfall with a peak intensity of just under 3 inches per hour. Today, our city's peak rainfall intensities of greater than 7 inches per hour. This is more than double the new design capacity. The new stormwater systems have only been installed in approximately 15% of the city.</=trong> In neighborhoods that have not been upgraded, the city continues to work to remove water from the streets and swales.

There is still a lot of work to be done and we need to continue these efforts. We are in this together. It is important for residents and businesses to also do their part to protect themselves and their property. For businesses that know they are in low-lying and flood prone areas, this includes using flood panels when heavy rainfall is expected.&nb=p;

Today is a reminder that we need to all be prepared for unexpected weather events. Our Public Works Department is diligently working to respond to this flood event and will continue to work to respond when severe weather hits our city. Please see below the city's Assistant City Manager, Eric Carpenter's response to this event.
