Mr. Gordon,

I was in Matt's office when you called and I suggested that he forward any email's regarding your conversation.

I would suggest one of two options.

1) Provide us with the GIS coordinates of the property or simply go to Google Earth and capture a screen view of the property and its surroundings and send that to a scientist who is agreeable to discussing the property with you.
