I spoke to the international services at our school and according to them, As long as I am employed by an American company based in the US, and once I have my I-20 document, which they process once one commences employment, I would be allowed to make work authorized trips outside of the country. I would just need a letter from employer stating where and why I've been sent, upon reentry into the country. (Along with my visa, I-20= employment authorization card). And I have to keep my permanent (for 1 year on OPT) address in NYC.
