Several reasons we favor using ABQ.,

-First Fu=l Price is \$1.25 lower in ABQ than SAF., ABQ \$4.24 SAF \$=.25

- Second, Precision approaches to Two Long runways, 13,793ft a=d. 10,000ft runway., -only one precision ILS in SAF and usually d=esn't favor wind direction for landing, you have a circling approach, plus 3=00 ft mountains are 8 miles to the West, at night makes challenging, <=div>

-ABQ is safer all around than SAF.,
