I spoke this afternoon with Mr. Earl Thomas, of VIYA, he will free up some of his crew to address LSJ/GSJ and STC internet service on Tuesday the 26th. He states "he is not making any promises due to the additional damages that hurricane Maria has caused, but he will do his best to restore service. I am also looking into Surge and Broadband VI (other internet service providers), in case VIYA cannot restore service in an expedient fashion considering that they have to restore all services on all three islands.

On Monday the 25th I am scheduled to go to the hanger with some of Isj crew to repair the right side roll-in door to the tarmac. It is not rolling back to allow the heli to pass. The good news is that there wasn't any additional damages to the hanger.
