It has been some time since we last spoke and hope all is well with you.

Since leaving the dental school, I have been at the Mailman School of Public Health, which has been a terrific experience.

As you recall, you were kind enough to provide me with an unrestricted gift when I began my work at the School of Public Health. This support was invaluable, and contributed to advancing discussion about the future of the dental

profession, and the importance of oral findings in persons with diabetes mellitus. This resulted in the publication of 1 book, 2 monographs, 2 other book chapters and numerous papers in refereed journals.
