In response to your questions about the recent art purchases email below that I sent to Melanie yesterday (and apologies for not copying you on it – I promise I'm going to start remembering to do that!!):

1. Leon has already been invoiced for these purchases and we have paid for all of them, so it is too late to have Narrows pay, but I can certainly prepare a document signed by Leon that transfers ownership of these works from him to Narrows if you would like.
