I met with the Commissioner of Education and, according to her, the Black Aerospace Professionals is not an approved public school program or initiative. We can take the position that, because the governor asked you (in writing) to donate to this entity, we are therefore considering it to be a public school initiative even though it has not been officially sanctioned as such by the VDOE or the EDC (Note: all the programs and initiatives get specific individual letters designating them as such by the DOE and the EDC).

If we take the approach that they are so designated, we will need to donate an additional \$3,250 to a public school program or initiative for 2016. If we decide NOT to consider the Black Aerospace Professionals as a public School program or initiative, we will need to contribute an additional \$33,250 for 2016.
