The SR7009 receiver supports 4K passthrough. The TV supports HDMI 2.0 and 4K, but it doesn't appear to support HDR, so it will be REAT, but probably not quite AMAZING.

They should be able to swap the new Apple TV 4K for their existing Apple TV 4 and have it auto-detect 4K settings. If it fails, they may need to replace the HDMI cables (but that's unlikely).
