I know you said only the guest room corridor stopping before the upstairs landing... But I am just concerned what your eye will see.

When you get to the top of your staircase, to the left (bottom photo) where the guest room corridor is, there is no join in the carpet. And you may notice the new join as there may be a slight difference in old and new.

To the right (your bedroom) there is a wooden thing that would make the difference less noticeable.

But if you took it to your bedroom we may have to do the whole staircase as well. I thought maybe only the top step, but then depending on how the new carpet varies you may notice a difference between steps.

Also someone cut into the bottom step, so we have to do that one.
