We've collected blood in Boston before at the GET Conference and Labs <<http://personalgenomes.us8.list-manage.com/track/click?u=031211bd09e27107323c51b96&id=550c94c6e7&e=fc0f0cb85e>>, but attending the event isn't always possible, even for local residents. We also held a successful Saturday collection event in June but some participants were unable to attend.
