Good Day.

The barge has an issue that warrants taking it out of service for inspection and repair. The port propeller shaft has come loose from its taper in the drive coupling. It's a BIG deal. To fix it, very likely, is going to require hauling the barge out to repair it.

There is likely unseen damage to the shaft taper, coupling taper, coupling and nut. Inspection will determine if it can be repaired or replaced.

It's gotta be disassembled and evaluated and SBDD is the place it needs done. The failed weld on the muffler can be addressed at the same time the shaft inspection and subsequent repair is done.
