There are \$13,000 worth of days that [REDACTED] flew trips that I was not present on. These days are noted with a purple font and is included in the totals of work days and airline days. The previous spreadsheet I sent back in October did include these same dates, but was not included in the total of work days and airline days.

My work days were about 19% less this year than last year with only 78 work days in 2012 compared to 96 work days in 2011.
