Rich,

Mr. Epstein's desk is by Andre-Charles Boulle=and the value is above the 1986 purchase price. However, the side mou=ts were replaced in the 1760's with the lion's masks (dark=brown dot in each circled area shows where original mount was). This was a normal occurrence in the 18th century to make earlier=pieces more in line with current fashions.

Now, this is where it gets interesting. Sotheby=E2 s catalogue illustrates a cartonnier (illustrated below) whic= they described as "later" that came with the desk. &=bsp; Does Mr. Epstein have the cartonnier? It's ob=iously hard to say from this black and white photo, but stylistically, the cartonnier could be from=the 1760's. If so, it was likely made at the same time the li=n's masks were put on the sides and would make the desk significant=y more valuable.

If Mr. Epstein does have the cartonnier, we would need to see it to verify its age as it will obviously impact the value we give him. Also, what sort of value does Mr. Epstein need? Is he possibly interested in selling the desk?
