

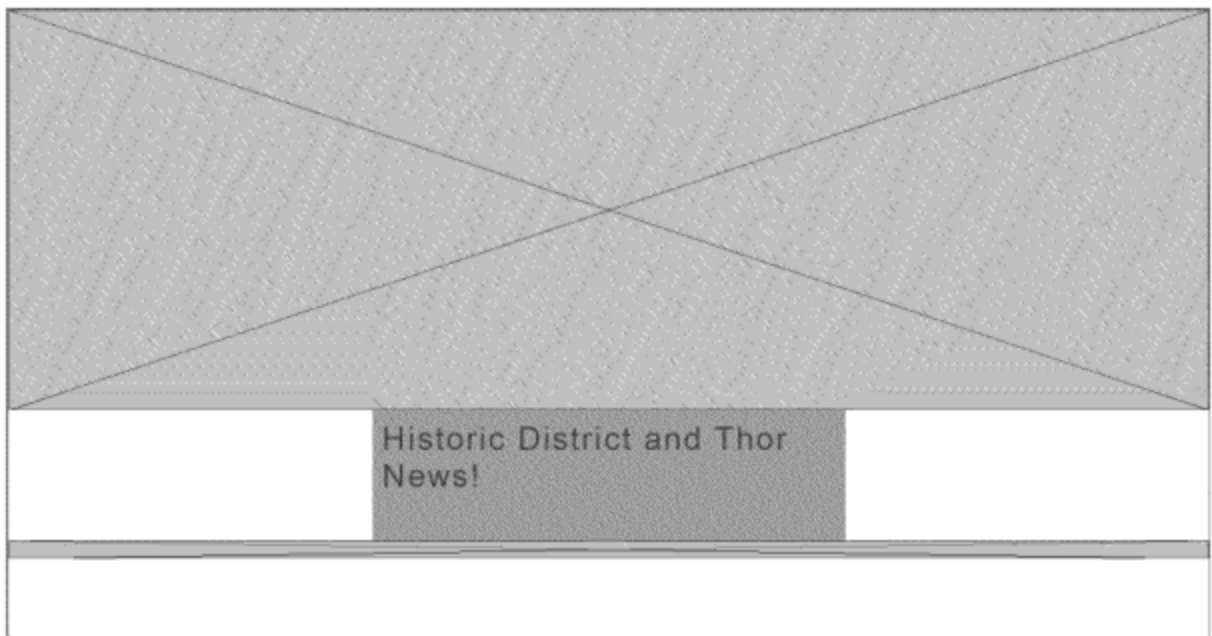

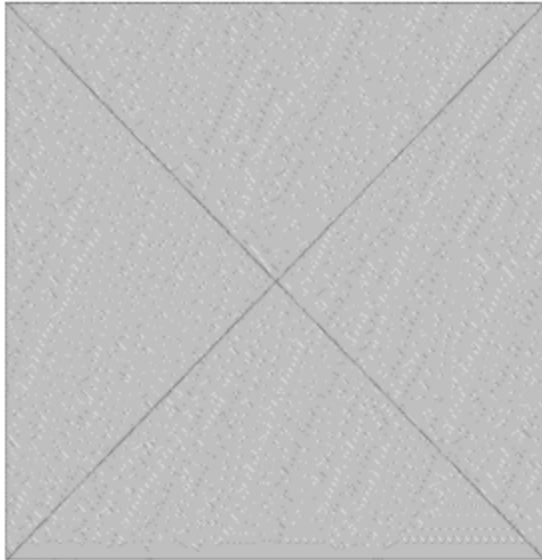

State Moves Toward Historic District

Designation

Save Coney Island is thrilled to announce that the New York State Historic Preservation Office has declared Coney Island's amusement district eligible for listing in the State and National Registers of Historic Places. While this does not protect the buildings within the district from demolition, inclusion on the Registers could offer financial incentives for redevelopment projects that rehabilitate and reuse historic properties in the amusement area.
