Frangi pani- Beautiful in bloom but deciduous Mr E would kill someone if he has to look at it bare

oleander-great plant but gets bugs

The other areas I will not comment on because I am not there to see the total area i.e. proximity to salt and light conditions. I will comment on how Mr E did not like the bromeliads at his house in Palm Beach and one of the other suggestions is pretty invasive.
