As Chairman of the Swedish-American Life Science Summit (SALSS) I am proud to invite you to this year's Summit, held in **Stockholm, Sweden, September 29th – October 1st**. I am familiar with your intriguing work on perception and memory, and, as our mutual friend Jeffrey Epstein warmly recommended I contact you in regards to SALSS, I am very pleased to invite you to speak at this year's Summit.
