VOTER REGISTRATION UNDERWAY

DEADLINE TO REGISTER IS OCTOBER 2ND

In order to register the following must apply:

Qualifications for Voting

- (a) Must be a citizen of the United States
- (b) Must be eighteen years of age
- (c) Must meet the residency requirement

Residency Requirement: (Virgin Islands)

- (a) Must be residing in the territory at least ninety (90) days before a primary or general election.
- (b) Must be residing in the election district at least ninety (90) days.

Registration Documents: (One Proof of Citizenship)

- (a) Birth Certificate
- (b) Passport (United States)
- (c) Naturalization Certificate
- (d) DD 214



ABSENTEE BALLOT DEADLINE

If you may not be able to vote in person on Tuesday, November 2nd, you need to request an absentee ballot by Tuesday, October 19th so that your vote will be counted!
