so i checked the book which is fabulous but you can tell jeffrey that i can do most
of the things in there even those pieces of furniture with a lot of mother of
pearl in-lay. its a lot of meticulous work of course, but its doable.
now regarding to his office in virgin island i was thinking that those coves around
the painting on the ceiling would look nice covered with moon-light gold leaf.
moon-light gold leaf is a very nice type of gold leaf, its something between
gold and silver..its not warm as gold and not cold as silver , and i think
would work very well with that painting having most of the colours cold and
with the furniture's wood which is kind of cold colour as well.
this is just a first thought... i was thinking at gold leafing because the surface its
curved and gold leafing looks very nice on curved surface, and of course its
not gonna be just raw gold leaf.., we can give a patina something related to
that whitish-bluish you can see on the furniture's wood. eventually some
borders on top of the gold using some pattern from the furniture..or maybe
some thin lines of gold on the wood, to relate ceiling to the furniture.
then the border around the painting in the middle of the ceiling it might look good
being like bronze..fake bronze or whatever to relate the painting to those
curved gold-leaved surfaces..
or if we dont want a smooth surface of the gold leafed surface, we can do a
texture.. imagine something like some very thin horizontal stripes.. some
stripe you would make with a comb, and then gold leafing that.. it might
look good with a good lightning.
anyway, gold leafing the ceiling means a lot of work and that would be very
expensive too because of the gold, but i think it would look gorgeous.
so, what do you think about this idea?
