

Dubai ruler 'not worried' about ability to repay debts

Dubai's bonds rallied and the cost to protect its debt slumped to the lowest since March after the emirate's ruler Sheikh Mohammed Bin Rashid Al Maktoum said he is "not worried" about its ability to repay debt.
