Jeffrey,

Please review the attached options for the cornice and beam treatment at the Office Pavilion.

Option A: Cornice band and exposed beams finished in stucco (EFIS).

Option B: Cornice and architrave band (upper and lower bands) finished in stucco (EFIS)
Beams finished in stone veneer.

Option B will cost an estimated plus/minus \$30,000 for the additional stone veneer and the required steel angle support. Actual cost will be determined once sent to bid.

Let me know which option we can proceed with for pricing and construction.
