We also need to sign up for a new health insurance, starting next month. =aiyo's celiac disease means that we see his doctors quite often, so th= deductibles should not be too high. The obvious options are Blue Cross Bl=e Shield of Massachusetts HMO Gold (1000 deductible, ~2250 per month for t=e whole family), or HMO Platinum (0 deductible, but 3000 per month, which =eems to be too much).

The alternatives are the Harvard Pilgrim and Tufts Healthplans, but they ha=e smaller networks and are not accepted by all our doctors, while being on=y slightly less expensive.

(Until now we were on the MIT Cobra plan, which extended the MIT Health Pla= for 18 months.)

Should we just sign up and pay via income or is there a better way this sho=ld be done that (saves taxes, for instance)?
