Hello Leighton, I have sat down and we came up with the best option for the plugs. The cost will be \$1.23 per plug (\$1.23 x 600= \$738). This price includes the 1 inch plugs, the die service, and the cutting (we figured the cutting would be better to do here even though it's very time consuming because we can make sure that the cuts are done as straight as possible and don't come out crooked). Once an invoice is made, the freight charges would be added separately. I can do them in any color you'd like but like I said, your bumpers are dark gray so I would go with dark gray for aesthetic. I have attached 2 pictures of a similar profile to give you a clearer look on what we are speaking about. The piece would be almost the same except it will not have the middle hole, it will be completely solid throughout. Unfortunately, we couldn't use this exact piece because it was way to big for the 1.5" hole that's on the bumper. Let me know how you would like to proceed.


