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it appear to me that "language can be defined as the biological organizing principle that creates a shape space. "coherent sentences" are defined as those that fit on the shape. the projection on the sensory motors, allows communication. . There are an infinite number of sentences that do fit on the shape, but orders of magnitude more, that do not fit. to attempt a naive representation, imagine a hemisphere, (symmetric), any continuous line drawn on its surface, is a sentence. there are infinite numbers of lines that can be drawn. however, trying to connect two points, directly without traversing the hemisphere is also infinitely possible but most solutions need to leave the surface. The principle that organizes the shape is NOT an input device. one can map inputs onto the shape but it is not the shape, in my hemisphere bowl in 3 space, analogy, one can put marbles in the bowl and they will map a path to the bottom. but the shape of the bowl determines how fast they move, and in which direction, the shape of the bowl is the language. there is a shape for vision as well. it exists without input, certain paths are more probable.

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
