Good news! J.P. Oriol of CZM has informed me they will accept the replacement vehicular and woodworking building as a Minor Permit. It will be configured as requested by Mr. Epstein parallel to the shore, near the line of natural abutment. What you need to do now is get the required paperwork from the City Governor's office so that we can file the permit. We will revise the preliminary design so that you can get pricing. The permit itself will take about 60 days to be approved. The other two structures on top of the R.O. and Generator Buildings will be done as permit modifications. Once you get the modification form signed by Mr. Epstein, we can file that. It will take approximately 2 – 3 weeks to be approved.
