SRF has:

- \* Conducted a current (April 27) Bridger Security check on all 8 closed/active SRF grantees from Ethiopia (including Nega). All came out without matches.
- \* Conducted Internet searches on these 8 grantees. Of the 8 grantees, only Nega has been noted in the press as part of the recent G7 alleged coup planning.
  - \* We have not found any statements in the press coming from Bucknell.
  - \* SAR- Rob Quinn has no other information than what we know.
  - \* As background, Nega received his PhD from The New School, and taught economics at CUNY from '87-'89 and at Bucknell '90-'94. He returned to Ethiopia in 1994.
- \* referred by SAR January 2006 (while in prison)
- \* References received from: New School (Dept. of Economics), AAAS (alert), Bucknell University (Dept. of Economics), Center for Economic and Policy Research (DC), Old Dominion University (VA),
- \* awarded February 15, 2006
- \* released from prison July 2007
- \* arrived in US September 2007
- \* arrived at Bucknell November 2007
- \* fellowship ended May 2008 (remained at Bucknell; did not apply for renewal)
