Option 1- Personally I would use small black satilte speakers to match the black frame of TV in kitchen, Audio Advisors is offering an open box sale, of an Infinity Black satellite speaker system with matching sub woofe=, includes a Yamaha home theater receiver for power for \$1,198.00 regular price was \$1,999.00 they only have this floor model left to sell. I=20 personally heard it,,,not a bad sound for the price.

Option 2- Best Buy has Bose system for \$2,999.00 in white that includes DVD or NEW BOSE LIFESTYLE 20 SERIES III DVD SYSTEM - WHITE on Ebay for \$1,999.00 we would purchase a Blue Ray for DVD, preferred system.
