DETAILS of the disturbing lifestyle led by Jeffrey Epstein emerged last night after the Daily Mail uncovered logs of telephone messages left at his Florida child sex den.

Schoolchildren were among hundreds of callers who apparently rang to arrange massages for the 58-year-old billionaire friend of Prince Andrew, who was later convicted of child sex offences.

And Ghislaine Maxwell, 49-year-old daughter of the disgraced media mogul Robert Maxwell, is apparently implicated in the procurement of massages. She once called to say: 'She has females for Mr JE.'

Messages with sickening overtones are contained in a phone book, including a message from someone called Jeanluc for Epstein: 'He just did a good one – 18 years. (She spoke to me and said, "I love Jeffrey").'

The long list of women is punctuated by regular references to Epstein's celebrity friends including the business magnate Donald Trump, film producer Harvey Weinstein, magician David Copperfield, referred to as 'Magic David'.

The sheer volume of phone traffic shows the frequency of Epstein's messages, many of which were 'erotic' and allegedly involved the abused girls.

The evidence is from documents confiscated by police during a criminal investigation into and seen yesterday by the Mail.

One message left for Epstein reads: 'She is wondering if 2.30 ok cuz she needs to stay in school.'

It was left in February 2005 – the same year that the mother of a 14-year-old girl alerted police to Epstein

Another note shows that 'Colleen' phoned to tell Epstein: 'Going into class – will be out in 45 min'

Someone called Tatum is mentioned regularly in the logs. A note for Epstein from her says: 'Has girl for tonight.'

Caroline rang to say: 'I need work. I don't have money. Do you have some work for me?'

And Amanda phoned to ask Epstein 'if she should bring her friend Holly with tonight'.

Some of the messages appear to show the girls' affection for Epstein, such as 'Tatyana called to say goodnight'.

Last night the Daily Mail tried to contact the people whose names and telephone numbers are included in the logs.

One girl named Jenny, who had left her number, hung up immediately when asked about Epstein.

A man listed only as Darren said: 'Ma'am, I have no comment to make on that.'

Another number left by someone called Aria was answered by a girl who spoke only Turkish.
