If the glue is compromised the air leaks from underneath the door seal, mos= likely would happen to us.

We have the upgraded door seal and moisture separating air pump that we cha=ged two years ago.

There are several functional checks Pete will do to make sure it's =ot a mechanical failure or dirty air filter for  
door seal,,

-to check if the glue is compromised, you have to manually inflate the door=seal and Pull to see if it separates  
from the door channel
