There are 2 options the lamp guys are suggesting for electrifying the monkey sculpture; one is drilling and attaching on top of the head, but with this option, the black cord would have to run down the length of the monkey's back; don't think that would look the best and the lamp shade wouldn't be centered. (photos 1 and 2) The second option would be to drill and mount on one of the sides of the base. (photo 3) I think I prefer this option, but we would just have to determine which side would be better to mount on.

For the red sculpture, there is really only one option which makes sense, to drill through the wicker in the back and put the pole through the hole. My only concern with this is if that will cause the wicker to start to unravel. The guys didn't seem too concerned about this happening, but it was a thought of mine.
