**Subject:** Today is the 50th anniversary of the Cuba Missile crises

A half-century ago today, the Cuban missile crises began. On October 26, 1962, President John F. Kennedy, after learning that the Soviet Union had secretly installing missiles in Castro's Cuba, responded boldly and decisively. Placing American forces on their highest state of alert, he gave the Soviet Union an ultimatum: Remove all the missiles from Cuba or face a nuclear war. Thirteen days later, the Soviet Union acquiesced. The missiles were removed but Fidel Castro remained in power. So JFK decided to remove Castro by other means. The CIA recruited an assassin in Castro's inner circle. But Castro learned of the plot in September 1963. So began a deadly dance of between the CIA and Castro's intelligence service that culminated on November 22, 1963 with the assassination of Kennedy in Dallas.
