Bryan has tried to reason with her and said, give me the bills or jus= make a compromise and finish. Both parties just want to finish. &n=sp; She is insiisting I signed the change order forms and she has me over = barrel because I signed the contract.

The=e are bills for \$95,000 for mouldings. \$35,000 for electrical. Ther= is NO backup.

She already took me t= a fireplace company and charged me \$11,000 for a \$5,000 fireplace. =nbsp;

I am being taken advantage of.
