I spoke with James and Bo this morning regarding Mr. E=stein's inquiry to wrap the veneer around the bullnose edges on the=Veneer instead of stopping it and using a hardwood. They evaluated ea=h of the ledges, tables and credenza top and determined that due to the design of the furniture and the linear silver bi=ch veneer, they do not recommend wrapping the hardwood in the veneer/single=ply. I have attached photos showing the details of your ledges and th= areas of concern.
