The population of 1,500 people were using 2,000 barrels of diesel a ye=r to power generators for heir electricity — costing the islands \$=25,000 a year.

"Electricity expenses make up a huge portion of their budget in Tokela=, which makes it hard for them to invest and look toward the future, so th=re's a very clear financial argument for this system," said Michael Bassett-Smith<=A>, managing director of PowerSmart Solar, New Zealand's largest s=lar power company, which directed the project.

Rising waters from climate change are causing significant coastal eros=on on the islands, so they set up the arrays not just to save money, but t= battle climate change and help ensure their survival
