> I've been connecting regularly with Hank Kaplan. I suggested sending sample both to Foundation Medicine (for clinical grade testing of a subset of the genome) and to the Broad Institute (for research grade testing of the entire genome).
>
> I touched base with Hank yesterday to see how that was going. He replied that a pathologist is working on getting sample to Foundation Medicine.
>
> I'm not sure if there is interest (or ability) to send more to the Broad - would require some sort of local research protocol). But I'm glad that things are in motion with Foundation (I've let them know to expect a sample, and I'll stay involved with analysis). I think the Foundation test will likely give most of what's clinically actionable.
>
> I'll keep you posted on any further progress (though I admit it does seem a bit slow).
